

Resolution from the Driver Education National Standards Meeting
Phoenix, AZ
February 19, 2009

Whereas, NHTSA brought together the driver education community to develop national standards;

Whereas, this document represents a starting point;

Whereas, it is understood that this document will be enhanced on an ongoing basis as additional research is developed;

Now therefore, each major organization that participated in the development of the “national standards” will have its governance body (as appropriate to that organization) formally consider this document and seek approval to:

1. Support this document in principle and encourage its adoption in the states, its future evolution and to participate in the process of refining this document.
2. Form an association of stakeholders charged with implementing the document recommendations, establishing an agenda to complete the next steps identified when this document was developed, and to revise the document and work together with other national organizations to realize the vision for an enhanced driver education system in North America embodied in this document.
