

Want to submit a comment to the MYs 2017-2025 CAFE/GHG NPRM?

- Fill in your comments in the field on the right
 - If your comments are more than 2000 characters long, you can upload additional comments as a separate file using the field "3. UPLOAD FILES."
- Fill in your information in the fields on the left
 - You may submit anonymous comments if you wish, but providing information to help the agency contact you is important in case there are technical problems with your comments or the agency has questions regarding your submission.
- Please note!
 - Everything submitted on regulations.gov can be read by anyone. If you wish to submit confidential information, contact the agency directly.
 - The comment submission page times out after 20 minutes. If you need more time than that to complete your comments, be sure to continue your session

when prompted; otherwise, the page will expire and your comment will not be submitted.

- You can click the “Preview comment” link toward the bottom right of the page before submitting your comment to see how it will appear in the docket.
- Once you hit “Submit,” you will receive a comment tracking number which you can enter in the search field on the regulations.gov homepage in order to find your comment again.
- It may take several days for your comment to show up in the regulations.gov docket, especially toward the end of the comment period. This is normal. If you are concerned that your comment did not upload properly, you may contact the agency directly.
